### Reading

Even though reading is not on our school improvement plan it is still a focus for the children and teachers in the school. In the early years we work on basic skills with children, including phonics, sight words and book discussions. As children progress through the school they are taught reading comprehension strategies and encouraged to read regularly. Research shows that reading is improved through reading practice. Encouraging your child to read at home will add to their progress and achievement.

Year 1 & 2 Running Records results for term 1 compared with term 3, 2018, showed:

Stickers have started to come in. Please let your friends and relatives, who shop at Woolworths, know that we are happy to receive stickers throughout the campaign.

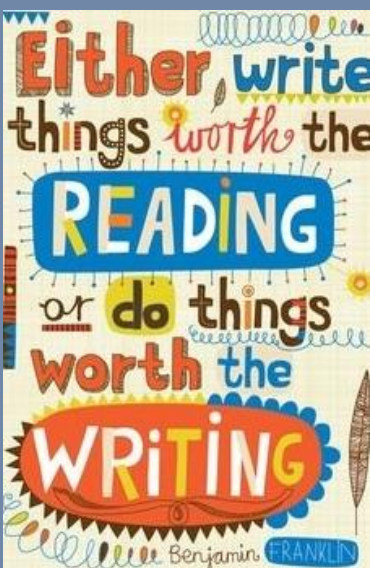
### Head lice

- pillowcases.



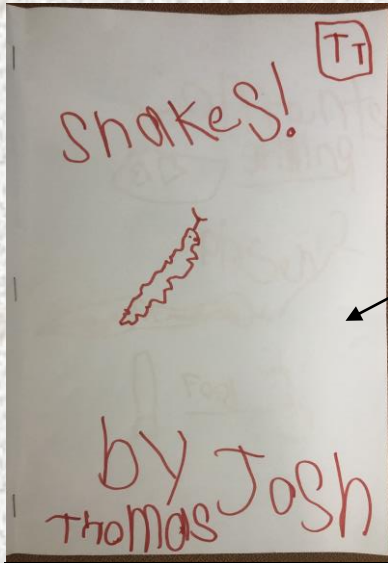

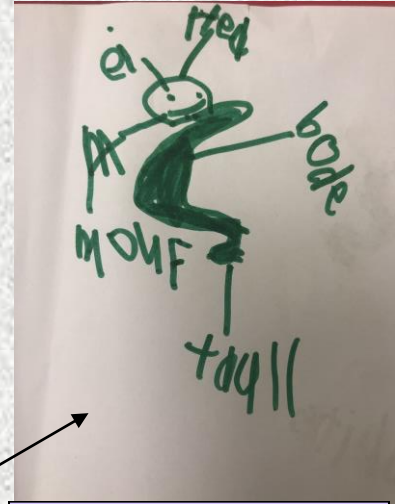
# Writing in the R/1 Learning Area

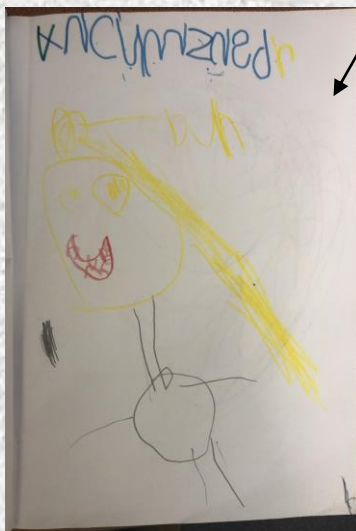
"Snakes" by Joshua

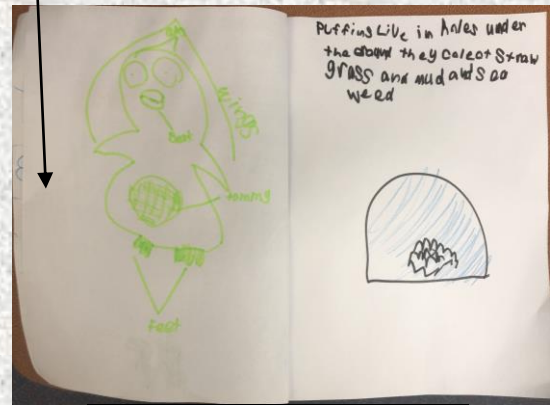


"Snakes" by Caleb

Diagrams with labels.

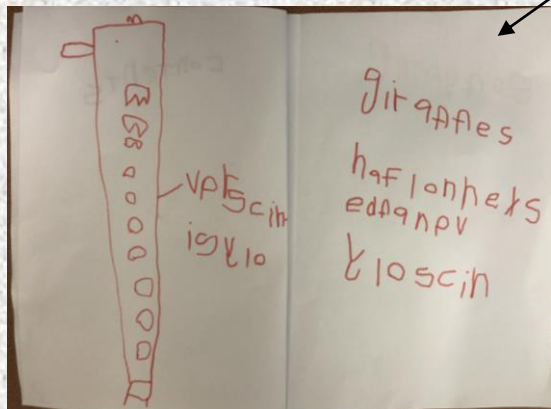

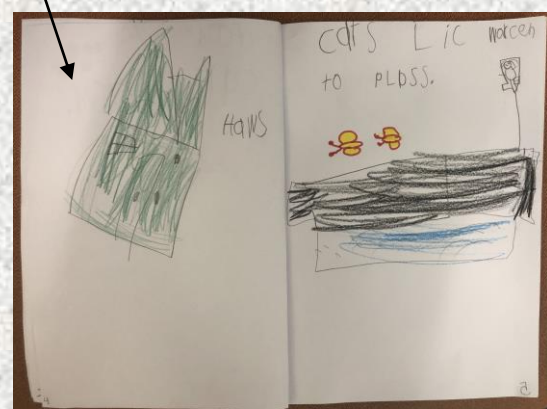
