- build their confidence by taking on personal challenges by: **providing your child with opportunities to build confidence and learn how to deal with obstacles, success and failure when they undertake personal challenges.**

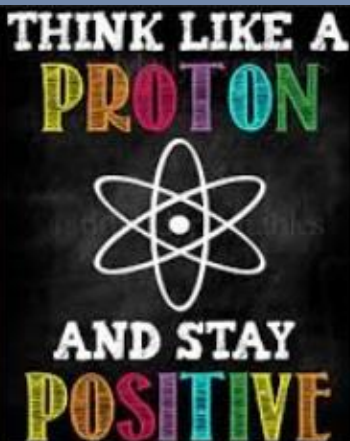
Casual Clothes Day Notice

MOULD

The Titanium Tigers conducted an experiment to determine the best conditions to grow mould in order keep bread fresh longer. Most Tiger scientists found that damp and dark conditions were ideal for mould growth as mould doesn't like dry and light environments.
