Good social distancing and hygiene.

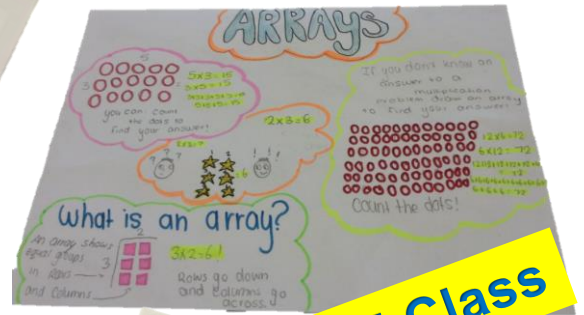
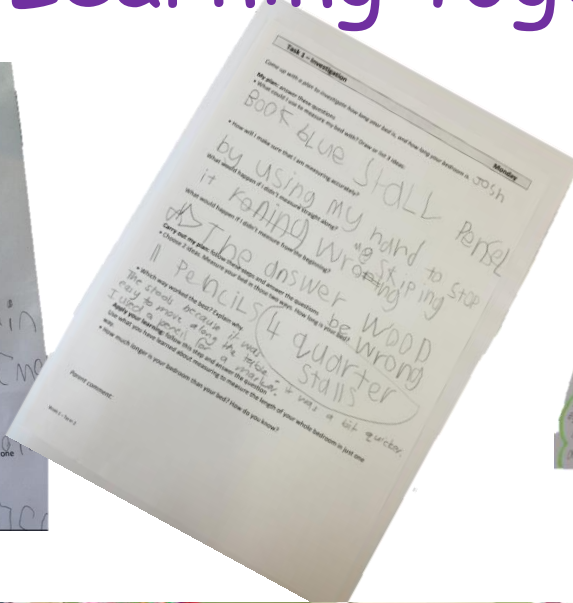
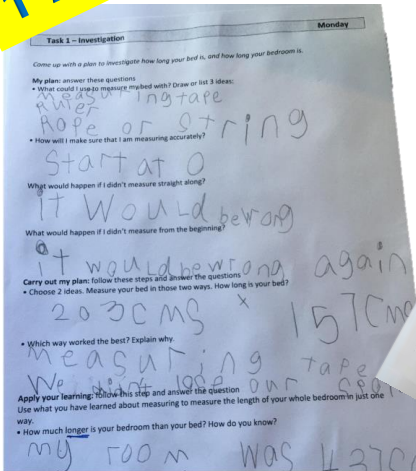

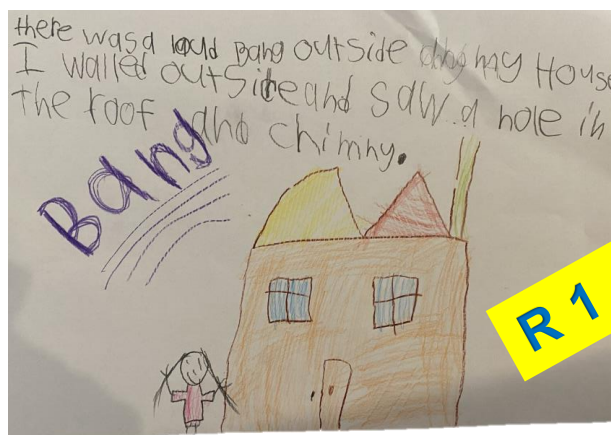
