

# 2023 School Improvement Plan Summary

## Gladstone Primary School

### Goals

To increase the number of students achieving in High Bands in NAPLAN Writing.

### Targets

2022:  
 100% of year 3 students (8/8) above SEA in NAPLAN reading.  
 75% of year 5 students (6/8) above SEA in NAPLAN reading.  
 37.5% of year 3 students (3/8) HB in NAPLAN reading.  
 37.5% of year 5 students (3/8) HB in NAPLAN reading.  
 100% achieved NMS

2023:  
 Year 3 – 33% of students (2/6) in HB writing.  
 Year 5 – 67% of students (8/12) in HB in writing which will be an increase of 67% from 2021.

### Challenge of Practice

If we explicitly teach sentence structure, punctuation and paragraphs then we will increase the number of students in HB writing.

### Success Criteria

Students will write, review and articulate their learning steps in collaboration with their teacher. Students writing samples will demonstrate punctuation, sentence structure and paragraphs when reviewed and/or assessed.

To improve students' achievements in mathematics R to 6.

2022:  
 100% of year 3 students (8/8) above SEA in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 100% of year 5 students (8/8) above SEA in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 63% of year 3 students (5/8) in HB in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 0% of year 5 students (0/8) in HB in NAPLAN numeracy.

2023:  
 Year 3 – 83% of students (5/6) above SEA in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 Year 5 – 33% of students (2/6) in HB in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 Year 3 – 100% of students (11/11) above SEA in NAPLAN numeracy.  
 Year 5 – 63% of students (7/11) in HB in NAPLAN numeracy.


2024:

If we collect a range of data to analyse and identify gaps in learning, then we can use the Australian Curriculum to address the gaps and improve learning outcomes for all students.

Students will satisfactorily meet the mathematics achievement standard when we do pre and post assessments. Students will understand and use efficient strategies when we implement targeted numeracy intervention.
